SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4162 as passed by the House:

The bill would amend the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969 to continue the exemption of workers' compensation proceedings from the hearings and appeals provisions of the Act. The exemption would apply to any matter or proceeding pending on the effective date of the bill and to any matter for which an application under the Workers' Disability Compensation Act had been filed after March 31, 1986.
