



HOUSE BILL No. 5427

November 29, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Bodem, Bush, Middaugh, Randall and Alley and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to provide for certain revenue received from the secretary of state by state supported universities of higher education and to provide for its expenditure.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) The governing board of a state supported uni-
2 versity of higher education may accept money from university reg-
3 istration plate service fees collected by the secretary of state
4 under section 811e of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of
5 the Public Acts of 1949, being section 257.811e of the Michigan
6 Compiled Laws.

7 (2) Money accepted under this section shall only be expended
8 for instructional services and research.

9 (3) The governing board shall account to the legislature for
10 all the income and expenditures by the university under this
11 section in the annual accounting required under section 1 of Act

1 No. 42 of the Public Acts of the Second Extra Session of 1963,
2 being section 390.1101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

3 Sec. 3. This act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill
4 No. _____ or House Bill No. 5428 (request no. 06284'95) of
5 the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
