

HOUSE BILL No. 5927

June 6, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to require a consumer's signature on agreements to renew his or her liability under certain consumer contracts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Consumer" means an individual who purchases a good or
- 3 service primarily for the individual's personal, family, or
- 4 household use.
- 5 (b) "Consumer contract" means an agreement obligating a con-
- 6 sumer to accept and pay for a good or service that is purchased
- 7 primarily for the consumer's personal, family, or household use.
- 8 Sec. 2. An agreement to renew a consumer contract is void
- 9 unless the agreement is both of the following:
- (a) In a writing that specifies the contract renewal period
- 11 and terms.
