A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4012 AS INTRODUCED 1-8-97

The bill would add a new section to Chapter VIII (Trials) of the Code of Criminal Procedure to authorize courts, except as otherwise provided by law, to order that sentences for felony or misdemeanor convictions be served consecutively with earlier sentences or for another sentence arising out of a conviction for the same transaction. The bill would apply to sentences imposed on or after the date that the bill took effect.
