A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4761 AS INTRODUCED 5-7-97

The bill would create a new act to establish a grant program in the Department of State to benefit state historical facilities. Beginning January 1, 1998, and each year thereafter, the department would be required to provide matching funds to state historical facilities, dollar for dollar, up to \$200,000 per year, for all funds donated from whatever source to the Michigan Historical Center Foundation. The bill specifies that the legislature would make an appropriation each year for this purpose, and that the funds appropriated would be in addition to, and would not supplant, state funds otherwise appropriated to state historical facilities.
