SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5219

A bill to amend 1994 PA 358, entitled

"An act to regulate the possession of ferrets; to provide for the licensing of ferrets; to provide for requirements for importation and rabies control procedures for ferrets; to provide for the powers and duties of certain governmental entities; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 287.892).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) A person shall not own or harbor a ferret over
- 2 12 weeks of age unless the ferret has a current vaccination
- 3 against rabies with an approved rabies vaccine administered by a
- 4 veterinarian, except that rabies vaccinations are not required
- 5 for research ferrets kept at research facilities registered pur-
- 6 suant to the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts
- 7 of 1978, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
