THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16621. (1) The Michigan board of dentistry is created
- 2 in the department. The SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), THE board

- 4 meet the requirements of part 161: ——
- 5 (A) SEVEN dentists. —, 2 ONE OR MORE OF THE DENTISTS
- 6 APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION MAY HAVE A HEALTH PROFESSION
- 7 SPECIALTY CERTIFICATION ISSUED UNDER SECTION 16608.
- 8 (B) TWO DENTISTS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED A HEALTH PROFESSION
- 9 SPECIALTY CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 16608.
- 10 (C) TWO dental hygienists. —, 2

- (2) A DENTIST WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD AS OF THE EFFEC-3

- 5 SERVE OUT HIS OR HER TERM.
- (3) The board meeting dates and times shall be concurred in 6

 (5) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE TO HAVE THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AND INDUSTRY SERVICES REVIEW THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF DENTISTRY BY APRIL 30, 1999. THIS REVIEW SHALL IS ADEQUACY OF THE CURRENT BOARD COMPOSITION IN RESPONDING TO THIS REVIEW SHALL INCLUDE THE PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE CONCERN.
