## HOUSE BILL No. 4296

February 12, 1997, Introduced by Reps. Hammerstrom, DeHart, Gire, Leland, Law and Rhead and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending sections 16131 and 16263 (MCL 333.16131 and 333.16263), as amended by 1995 PA 126, and by adding section 16350 and part 189.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 16131. The terms of office of individual members of
 the boards and task forces, except those appointed to fill vacan cies, shall expire 4 years after appointment as follows:

OF 1 YEAR TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS OF SUBSECTION (1). THE LIMITED LICENSE MAY ONLY BE RENEWED
FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR PERIOD UPON APPLICATION OF THE LICENSEE
TO THE BOARD AND UPON THE DEMONSTRATION OF EXCEPTIONAL
CIRCUMSTANCES AS PRESCRIBED IN A RULE PROMULGATED BY THE BOARD.
