

HOUSE BILL No. 5347

November 4, 1997, Introduced by Reps. Varga and Johnson and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 152, entitled
"State license fee act,"
by amending section 25 (MCL 338.2225), as amended by 1988 PA
461.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 25. (1) Fees for a person licensed or seeking licen-
2 sure as a cosmetologist, manicurist, electrologist, or instruc-
3 tor, or a person licensed or seeking licensure to operate a
4 cosmetological establishment or school of cosmetology or seeking
5 a student registration or transfer, or seeking a permit to con-
6 duct an apprenticeship program under article 12 of the occupa-
7 tional code, ~~being sections 339.1201 to 339.1218 of the Michigan~~
8 ~~Compiled Laws~~ 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.1201 TO 339.1218, are as

22	(2) A COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND IS ESTABLISHED IN THE	
23	STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE COSME-	
24	TOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND THE MONEY THAT IS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE	
25	INCREASE IN THE PER YEAR LICENSE FEE UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(C)	
26	RESULTING FROM THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION.	
27	THE MONEY IN THE COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND SHALL ONLY BE	

1 EXPENDED AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3). THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE
2 IN THE COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL
3 YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND AND SHALL
4 NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT
5 THE INVESTMENT OF THE COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND AND SHALL
6 CREDIT INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT TO THE COSMETOL-
7 OGY ENFORCEMENT FUND. THE COSMETOLOGY ENFORCEMENT FUND MAY
8 RECEIVE GIFTS AND DEVICES AND OTHER MONEY AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

9 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE THE MONEY IN THE COSMETOLOGY
10 ENFORCEMENT FUND EACH FISCAL YEAR ONLY FOR THE TRAINING OF
11 INSPECTORS AND FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE COSMETOLOGY INSPECTION PRO-
12 VISIONS UNDER ARTICLE 12 OF THE OCCUPATIONAL CODE, 1980 PA 299,
13 MCL 339.1201 TO 339.1218.
