

SENATE BILL NO. 558

June 4, 1997, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN, BULLARD,
SHUGARS, BENNETT, ROGERS and GOUGEON and referred to the
Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 228, entitled
"Single business tax act,"
by amending section 4 (MCL 390.1304), as amended by 1980 PA 386,
and by adding section 4a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4. A person ~~shall be~~ IS eligible for a scholarship
2 award if the person meets all of the following qualifications:

3 (a) Has resided in this state continuously for the preceding
4 12 months and is not considered a resident of any other state.

5 (b) Has not graduated from high school at the time of the
6 scholarship examination.

7 (c) Enrolls in a recognized postsecondary educational insti-
8 tution within 4 years after graduation from high school and is
9 not enrolled in a program of study leading to a degree in
10 theology, divinity, or religious education.

1 (D) IS NOT INELIGIBLE UNDER SECTION 4A.
2 SEC. 4A. IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS SUBJECT TO A COURT ORDER DENY-
3 ING FEDERAL BENEFITS AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 421 OF PART D OF THE
4 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT, TITLE II OF THE COMPREHENSIVE DRUG
5 ABUSE PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT OF 1970, PUBLIC LAW 91-513, 21
6 U.S.C. 862, THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP
7 AWARD UNDER THIS ACT FOR THE DURATION OF THE COURT ORDER.
