

SENATE BILL NO. 991

March 3, 1998, Introduced by Senator GEAKE and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 214, entitled

"An act to enact a law to define the offense of felonious driving, when committed by the operation of a vehicle and to prescribe penalties therefor,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 752.192).
