A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5676 AS INTRODUCED 4-25-00

The bill would repeal House Concurrent Resolution No. 30 of 1931, that designated the robin as the state bird, and create a new act to designate the Kirtland's warbler (*Dendroica kirtlandii*) as the official state bird.
