## HOUSE BILL NO. 4414

(As amended September 23, 1998)

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 2552 (MCL 600.2552), as amended by 1994 PA 154.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2552. (1) A witness who attends any action or proceed-
- 2 ing pending in a court of record shall be paid a witness fee of
- 3 \$12.00 for each day and \$6.00 for each half day, or may be paid
- 4 for his or her loss of working time but not more than \$15.00 for
- 5 each day shall be taxable as costs as his or her witness fee. [A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 7 AND 13 OF CHAPTER XV OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1927 PA 175, MCL 775.7 AND 775.13, A]
