THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 4H. [(1)] A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE
- 2 FROM THE GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX THE
- 3 SALE OF A CASKET OR OTHER [] CONTAINER FOR THE BURIAL
- 4 OF ANY HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERAN OF A FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED
- **5** BRANCH OF SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES. [THE FAMILY OF THE DECEASED VETERAN SHALL SUBMIT VERIFICATION OF THE HONORABLE DISCHARGE WITHIN 240 DAYS OF INTERMENT.
 - (2) EACH YEAR THE STATE TREASURER SHALL ESTIMATE THE AMOUNT OF SALES TAX THAT WAS NOT COLLECTED BECAUSE OF THIS EXEMPTION AND THAT AMOUNT SHALL BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE SCHOOL AID FUND.]
