HOUSE BILL NO. 5962

(As passed the House, November 30, 2000)

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
by amending section 1301 (MCL 600.1301).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 1301. (1) In counties having a population of less than  
2 2,000,000, the jury board ~~shall consist~~ CONSISTS of 3 qualified  
3 electors of the county appointed by the ~~governor~~ COUNTY BOARD  
4 OF COMMISSIONERS on recommendation of the circuit judges of the  
5 judicial circuit in which the county is situated, not more than 2  
6 of whom shall be members of the same political party. The ~~first~~  
7 ~~appointment of members of the jury board shall be for terms of 2,~~  
8 ~~4 and 6 years. Thereafter~~ appointments shall be for 6-year  
9 terms.

10       (2) In counties having a population of 2,000,000 or more,  
11 the jury board ~~shall consist~~ CONSISTS of 7 qualified electors

18 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2). ~~If the number of board members is less~~  
19 ~~than previously, appointments to fill vacancies shall not be made~~  
20 ~~until the authorized number is reached. The board of supervisors~~  
21 ~~may prescribe the procedure for the orderly transition of~~
