 FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL NOT INFORM ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL OR
 REPRESENT TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL BY IDENTIFICATION OR ANY OTHER
 MEANS THAT HE OR SHE IS EMPLOYED BY THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE
 AGENCY WITH INTENT TO DO 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

6 (A) GAIN OR ATTEMPT TO GAIN ENTRY TO A RESIDENCE, BUILDING,7 STRUCTURE, FACILITY, OR OTHER PROPERTY.

8 (B) REMAIN OR ATTEMPT TO REMAIN IN OR UPON A RESIDENCE,9 BUILDING, STRUCTURE, FACILITY, OR OTHER PROPERTY.

10 (C) GAIN OR ATTEMPT TO GAIN ACCESS TO FINANCIAL ACCOUNT 11 INFORMATION.
