

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5031**

October 26, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Brewer, Kelly, LaForge and Quarles and referred to the Committee on Constitutional Law and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 223a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 223A. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF
- 2 SELLING FIREARMS IN THIS STATE SHALL INCLUDE A TRIGGER LOCK WITH
- 3 THE SALE OF EACH FIREARM. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "TRIGGER
- 4 LOCK" MEANS A DEVICE OPERATED BY A KEY OR COMBINATION LOCK OR A
- 5 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR MECHANISM THAT IS DESIGNED FOR USE ON FIRE-
- 6 ARMS, IS COMMERCIALLY AVAILABLE, AND DISABLES THE TRIGGER MECHA-
- 7 NISM OF THE FIREARM TO PREVENT THE DISCHARGE OF THAT FIREARM.
- 8 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
- 9 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR
- 10 OR BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
