



HOUSE BILL No. 5933

June 21, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Daniels, Stallworth, Rison, Reeves, Hardman, Basham, Brewer, Neumann and Pestka and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 16f of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16f), as amended by 1999 PA 45.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 16f. This chapter applies to the following felonies enumerated in chapter 750 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
