## SENATE BILL NO. 422

March 10, 1999, Introduced by Senator JAYE and referred to the Committee on Gaming and Casino Oversight.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 304 and 306 (MCL 750.304 and 750.306).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 304. (1) Selling pools and registering bets--Any A
- 2 person or his A PERSON'S agent or employe, who shall,
- 3 EMPLOYEE SHALL NOT directly or indirectly keep, maintain, oper-
- 4 ate, or occupy any building or room or -any- part -thereof- OF A

- 1 knowingly permit any grounds or premises, owned, occupied, or

- 4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS quilty of a mis-
- 5 demeanor, punishable by imprisonment in the county jail FOR not
