

SENATE BILL No. 999

February 10, 2000, Introduced by Senators MURPHY, GOSCHKA, DINGELL, KOIVISTO, NORTH, MILLER, BENNETT, JOHNSON, DE BEAUSSAERT and STEIL and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend 1971 PA 227, entitled

"An act to prescribe the rights and duties of parties to home solicitation sales,"

(MCL 445.111 to 445.117) by adding section 15.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 15. (1) LOCAL EXCHANGE PROVIDERS SHALL NOTIFY THEIR
2 RESIDENTIAL SUBSCRIBERS TWICE A YEAR ON HOW TO ENROLL ON THE
3 REGISTER. THIS NOTIFICATION SHALL ACCOMPANY THE SUBSCRIBER'S
4 MONTHLY TELEPHONE BILL AND SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN COOPERATION WITH
5 THE COMMISSION.
6 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE NOTIFICATION REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION
7 (1), LOCAL EXCHANGE PROVIDERS, WORKING IN COOPERATION WITH THE
8 COMMISSION, ARE REQUIRED TO PLACE INFORMATION IN THEIR WHITE PAGE
9 TELEPHONE DIRECTORY INFORMING THEIR RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE
10 SUBSCRIBERS HOW TO BE INCLUDED IN THE REGISTER.

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
2 effect unless Senate Bill No. 990
3 of the 90th Legislature is enacted into
4 law.
