## **SENATE BILL No. 1200**

April 5, 2000, Introduced by Senator SCHWARZ and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 514.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 514. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 501 AND SUBJECT TO
- 2 THE QUOTA SYSTEM UNDER THIS ACT, THE COMMISSION MAY ISSUE A CLASS
- 3 B HOTEL LICENSE TO A HOTEL AND CONFERENCE CENTER OWNED AND OPER-
- 4 ATED BY A UNIVERSITY MEETING AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) CONTAINS A HOTEL WITH AT LEAST 150 GUEST ROOMS.
- 6 (B) HAS A RESTAURANT SEATING AT LEAST 125 GUESTS THAT SERVES
- 7 A FULL-MENU BREAKFAST, LUNCH, AND DINNER.
- 8 (C) HAS OVER 30,000 SOUARE FEET OF FLEXIBLE MEETING SPACE.
- 9 (D) IS OPEN YEAR-ROUND TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE PUBLIC AND
- LO TO SERVE THE MISSION OF THE HOSPITALITY PROGRAM.

- (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOSPITALITY PROGRAM" MEANS A 12
- 13 COURSE OF ACADEMIC STUDY THAT, AT A MINIMUM, IS A NATIONALLY
- 14 ACCREDITED PROGRAM AT BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATE LEVELS IN THE
- 15 HOSPITALITY BUSINESS THAT REQUIRES AT LEAST 120 SEMESTER CREDITS
- 16 OR THE EQUIVALENT FOR COMPLETION OF THE BACCALAUREATE DEGREE AND
- 17 THAT HAS A TEACHING AND RESEARCH STAFF PREDOMINATED BY INDIVIDU-
- 18 ALS WITH AT LEAST DOCTORAL DEGREES.
