Section 13 of the Freedom of Information Act, 1976 PA 442 as amended, contains the language which exempts specific public records from public disclosure. House Bill 5349 would amend Section 13 of the Freedom of Information Act to add to the list of records that are exempt from disclosure, information regarding a public body's critical infrastructure.

In the bill, "critical infrastructure" is defined to mean a system that if incapacitated or destroyed would have a debilitating impact on the defense or economic security of the state and cause harm to the public health or welfare. "Critical infrastructure" would include, but would not be limited to, telecommunications systems, electrical power systems, gas, oil, and water supply systems, banking and finance, transportation, government services, and emergency services.

House Bill 5349 would have no fiscal impact on the state, nor on local units of government.
