A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5986 AS INTRODUCED 4-30-02

Under the Public School Employees Retirement Act, a member is granted one year of service credit [as a full-time employee] if he or she worked for at least 6 hours per day and for at least 170 days in a school year (1020 hours). Partial service credit is granted for employment of less than that amount.

<u>House Bill 5986</u> would amend this provision to add language specifying that if the member works for a reporting unit (a school district, intermediate school district, public school academy, community college, university, or other agency) that operates for less than 170 days in a school fiscal year, one year of retirement service credit would be granted if the member has worked at least 7.5 hours per day and at least 136 days in a school fiscal year (1020 hours).
