S.B. 1028: FLOOR ANALYSIS

## **CONTENT**

The bill would amend the Michigan Penal Code to increase the maximum fine in the penalty that applies to a felony or misdemeanor for which no other punishment is prescribed.

Currently, the penalty for a felony for which no other punishment is specially prescribed is imprisonment for up to four years, a maximum fine of \$2,000, or both. The bill would raise the maximum fine to \$5,000.

The current penalty for a misdemeanor for which no other punishment is specially prescribed is imprisonment for up to 90 days, a maximum fine of \$100, or both. The bill would raise the maximum fine to \$500.
