A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 2567a (MCL 600.2567a), as added by 1990 PA 346.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2567a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 2 (4), the county register of deeds shall collect a fee of \$2.00
- 3 for recording any instrument. BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2013, THE FEE
- 4 SHALL BE \$4.00. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2013, THE FEE SHALL BE
- 5 \$2.00. The fee shall be paid when the instrument is left for
- 6 record.
- 7 (2) The fee required by this section is in addition to any
- 8 other fees required in section 2567 or fees or charges
- 9 otherwise required by law for the recording of instruments.
