## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 63

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 2567 (MCL 600.2567), as amended by 1990 PA 346, and by adding section 2568.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2567. (1) A EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), A
- 2 register of deeds is entitled to the following fees, which are
- 3 not taxable as costs except as indicated:
- 4 (a) For entering and recording a deed, mortgage, certified

- 5 UNDER SECTION 2568. FOR ANY DOCUMENT THAT ASSIGNS OR DISCHARGES
