

SB 614, As Passed Senate, December 5, 2002

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 614**

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 217i.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 217I. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
2 SECTION 811E AND, UPON APPLICATION, MAY ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F
3 A STATE-SPONSORED SUPPORT EDUCATION FUND-RAISING REGISTRATION
4 PLATE AND A MATCHING STATE-SPONSORED SUPPORT EDUCATION COLLECTOR
5 PLATE AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 811G. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCA-
6 TION SHALL CONDUCT A STATEWIDE STUDENT CONTEST TO DETERMINE THE
7 DESIGN OF THE PLATE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE SECRETARY OF
8 STATE.
9 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEPOSIT THE DONATION INTO
10 THE "SUPPORT EDUCATION" FUND CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY UNDER
11 SUBSECTION (4). THE MONEY SHALL ONLY BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENT

1 OF EDUCATION. THE MONEY SHALL FUND MINIGRANTS TO CERTIFIED
2 TEACHERS FOR SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT THAT ENHANCE STUDENT LEARNING
3 WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON READING AND MATHEMATICS.

4 (3) SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE MONEY FROM THE FUND CREATED
5 IN SUBSECTION (4) SHALL BE USED TO FUND MINIGRANTS OF NOT MORE
6 THAN \$500.00 TO CERTAIN CERTIFIED TEACHERS IN THE COUNTY WHERE
7 THE PLATES WERE PURCHASED. THE REMAINING 25% OF THE MONEY SHALL
8 BE DISTRIBUTED TO CERTIFIED TEACHERS WHERE THERE IS HIGH NEED BUT
9 A LOW NUMBER OF SUPPORT [REDACTED] EDUCATION REGISTRATIONS.

10 (4) THE SUPPORT EDUCATION FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
11 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
12 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
13 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
14 SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND
15 INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR
16 SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect May 1,
18 2003.

19 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take
20 effect unless all of the following bills of the 91st Legislature
21 are enacted into law:
