SENATE BILL NO. 1029

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending sections 449, 450, and 462 (MCL 750.449, 750.450, and  
750.462).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 449. ~~Any~~ A person ~~, male or female, 17~~ 16 years of  
2 age or older ~~,~~ who ~~shall receive~~ RECEIVES or ~~admit~~ ADMITS  
3 or ~~offer~~ OFFERS to receive or admit ~~any~~ A person into ~~any~~ A  
4 place, structure, house, building, or vehicle for the purpose of  
5 prostitution, lewdness, or assignation, or who ~~shall~~ knowingly  
6 ~~permit any~~ PERMITS A person to remain in ~~any such place~~ A  
7 PLACE, STRUCTURE, HOUSE, BUILDING, OR VEHICLE for ~~any such~~ THE  
8 purpose OF PROSTITUTION, LEWDNESS, OR ASSIGNATION, ~~shall be~~ IS  
9 guilty of a ~~misdemeanor~~ CRIME PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION  
10 451.

1       Sec. 450. ~~Any~~ A person ~~, male or female, 17~~ 16 years of

10 ~~or convey~~ TAKES OR CONVEYS to, or ~~employ, receive, detain or~~  
11 ~~suffer~~ EMPLOYS, RECEIVES, DETAINS, OR ALLOWS A PERSON 16 YEARS  
12 OF AGE OR LESS to remain in, ~~any~~ A house of prostitution, house  
13 of ill-fame, bawdy-house, house of assignation, or ~~in~~ any house  
14 or place for the resort of prostitutes or other disorderly per-  
15 sons ~~, any female of the age of 17 years or under, shall be~~ IS  
16 guilty of a **misdemeanor CRIME PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION**  
17 **451.**

18       Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect  
19 June 1, 2002.

20       Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take  
21 effect unless all of the following bills of the 91st Legislature  
22 are enacted into law:
