October 23, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Faunce and Julian and referred to the Committee on Employment Relations, Training and Safety.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 397, entitled "Bullard-Plawecki employee right to know act," (MCL 423.501 to 423.512) by amending the title and by adding section 9a.

TITLE

An act to permit employees to review personnel records; to provide criteria for the review; to prescribe the information ~~which~~ THAT may be contained in personnel records; TO PRESCRIBE RESTRICTIONS ON THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN INFORMATION TO THIRD PARTIES; and to provide penalties.

SEC. 9A. IF AN EMPLOYER IS A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY AND IF THE EMPLOYEE IS A POLICE OFFICER, STATEMENTS MADE BY THE EMPLOYEE UNDER THREAT OF DISCHARGE FOR REMAINING SILENT ARE PRIVILEGED AND SHALL NOT BE RELEASED TO A THIRD PARTY WITHOUT THE EMPLOYEE'S
