- 3 MENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) IDENTIFY ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS COMMONLY USED OR FOUND
- 5 IN AREAS THAT ARE REASONABLY ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN.
- 6 (B) UTILIZING SCIENTIFIC PEER REVIEW, DEVELOP A LIST OF
- 7 ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS IDENTIFIED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A) WITH
- 8 KNOWN, LIKELY, OR SUSPECTED HEALTH RISKS TO CHILDREN.
- 9 (C) DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS TO HELP REDUCE OR ELIMINATE
- 10 EXPOSURE OF CHILDREN TO ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS LISTED UNDER
- 11 SUBDIVISION (B) IN AREAS REASONABLY ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN. IF
