- 1 Sec. 8123. (1) The forty-third district consists of the

- 10 (9) The fifty-first district consists of the township of
- 11 Waterford in the county of Oakland, is a district of the third
- 12 class, and has 2 judges.
- 13 (10) The fifty-second district consists of the county of
- 14 Oakland except the cities of Madison Heights, Ferndale, Hazel
- 15 Park, Royal Oak, Berkley, Huntington Woods, Oak Park, Pleasant
- 16 Ridge, Southfield, Lathrup Village, Farmington, Farmington Hills,
- 17 Northville, Sylvan Lake, Keego Harbor, Orchard Lake Village,
- 18 Birmingham, Bloomfield Hills, and Pontiac and the townships of
- 19 Royal Oak, Southfield, West Bloomfield, Bloomfield, and
- 20 Waterford, is a district of the second class, and is divided into

- 14 (c) The third division consists of the cities of Rochester,
- 15 Auburn Hills, Rochester Hills, and Lake Angelus and the townships
