THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "fund" means the nuclear waste
- 2 escrow fund created in section 2.
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) The nuclear waste escrow fund is created within
- 4 the state treasury.
- 5 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets
- 6 from any source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer
- 7 shall direct the investment of the fund. The state treasurer
- 8 shall credit to the fund interest and earnings from fund
- 9 investments.
 - (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
