## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1061. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY CANCEL A
- 2 REGULAR OR SPECIAL ELECTION BEFORE THE DATE OF THE ELECTION IF
- B ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
  - (A) THERE IS NO QUESTION ON THE BALLOT AT THE ELECTION OTHER
- THAN THE ELECTION OF SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS.
- (B) THE DEADLINE HAS PASSED FOR FILING A DECLARATION OF
- 7 INTENT TO BE A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE UNDER SECTION 737A OF THE
- 8 MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.737A.
- 9 (C) THERE IS NOT MORE THAN 1 CANDIDATE ON THE BALLOT FOR
- 10 EACH OFFICE ON THE BALLOT.

- 1 (2) IF AN ELECTION IS CANCELED UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE
- 2 CANDIDATE ON THE BALLOT FOR EACH OFFICE ON THE BALLOT SHALL BE
- 3 CONSIDERED ELECTED TO THAT OFFICE FOR ALL PURPOSES UNDER THIS ACT
