NONMICHIGAN SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

Analysis

Summary

This bill would prohibit the disposal of solid waste originating from other states or Canada unless the generating state or country has a solid waste disposal system that is at least as stringent and protective as provided in Michigan solid waste regulations.

The Department of Environmental Quality would be required to prepare a list of states and countries that the department has certified have regulatory systems at least as stringent as Michigan's. The Department would be required to determine if the annual amount of out of state waste in a given year exceeds the amount accepted by Michigan landfills during the previous 1-year period.

Fiscal Impact

The Department of Environmental Quality would be required to absorb the cost of increase surveillance anticipated by this bill. Funds would be redirected through the legislative transfer process. This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the on local governmental units.
