Analysis

Summary

This bill would allow an owner of a structure required to connect to a public sewer collection system to request an extension of to the deadline specified by a governmental unit. Such an extension could be considered if the septic system in place for the structure in question, is in good working order, and does not constitute threat to the public health. The Department of Environmental Quality would be required to adopt guidelines for local health departments to identify septic tank disposal systems that are in satisfactory operating condition.

Fiscal Impact

There would be no fiscal impact on the state or on local governmental units.
