Analysis Summary

HB 5195 would amend the Sex Offenders Registration Act to require that the compilation also contain the photograph of the individual that is required to be provided to the department under section 5a, if the individual had been convicted of a first-, second-, or third-degree criminal sexual conduct (CSC) involving penetration and the victim of the offense was less than 16 years of

age when the violation was committed.
