

HOUSE BILL No. 4250

February 19, 2003, Introduced by Reps. Daniels, Accavitti, Hager, Cheeks, Reeves, Hunter, Kolb, Whitmer, Hardman, Wojno, Woodward, Anderson, Waters, Zelenko, Clack, Gielegem, Stallworth, Bieda, Farrah, Vagnozzi and McConico and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411t.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 411t. (1) If a credit card or debit card is used for
2 payment in a consumer transaction, a person engaged in the
3 conduct of trade or commerce shall not issue or deliver a receipt
4 to the consumer that displays any part of the expiration date of
5 the card or more than the last 4 digits of the consumer's account
6 number.

7 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a
8 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00.

9 (3) As used in this section, "trade or commerce" means that
10 term as defined in section 2 of the Michigan consumer protection
11 act, 1976 PA 331, MCL 445.902.
