

HOUSE BILL No. 4451

March 25, 2003, Introduced by Reps. Hoogendyk, Milosch, Sheen, Brandenburg, Caswell, Voorhees, Pastor, Ruth Johnson, Rocca, Acciavatti, Amos, Robertson and Drolet and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to prohibit state agencies from requesting individuals' social security numbers.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act, "state agency" means a
2 department, board, commission, office, agency, authority, or
3 other unit of state government, or an individual or entity
4 contracting with the state or a state department to provide
5 services.

6 Sec. 2. Except as otherwise provided by law or for reason
7 of employment, a state agency shall not collect individuals'
8 social security numbers.
