- and the Jordan river valley management area, in which the federal

- 2 (b) A recommended strategy for acquiring the federal
- 3 subsurface oil and gas rights on the state lands identified under

- 5 (c) An analysis of the prospects for exchanging severed oil

- 7 identifying the key potential barriers to executing such
- 8 exchanges.
