- 4 outside of a metropolitan statistical area as defined in 42 USC
- 5 1395ww shall be located in a city, village, or township with a
- 6 population of no more than 10,000 and in a county with a
- population of no more than 110,000. A hospital that is
- 8 determined to be a rural hospital under this section may be
- 9 designated by the department as a critical provider to satisfy
- 10 the eligibility requirements for certification as a critical
- 11 access hospital.
