

SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4977

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5/ (MCL 28.425/), as amended by 2002 PA 719.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5/. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol issued
2 before July 1, 2003 is valid for 3 years, ~~and~~ a license to carry
3 a concealed pistol issued on or after July 1, 2003 **BUT BEFORE JULY**
4 **1, 2006** is valid for 5 years, **AND A LICENSE TO CARRY A CONCEALED**

1 PISTOL ISSUED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2006 IS VALID UNTIL THE
2 APPLICANT'S DATE OF BIRTH THAT FALLS NOT LESS THAN 5 YEARS OR MORE
3 THAN 6 YEARS AFTER THE LICENSE IS ISSUED. A renewal of a license
4 under section 5b shall be issued in the same manner as an original
5 license issued under section 5b.

6 (2) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) are
7 waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or retired
8 law enforcement officer.

9 (3) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) for an
10 applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under this act
11 are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he or she
12 has completed at least 3 hours' review of the training described
13 under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1 hour of firing range
14 time in the 6 months immediately preceding the subsequent
15 application.
