

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4977

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5/ (MCL 28.425/), as amended by 2006 PA 92.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5/. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol issued
2 before July 1, 2003 is valid for 3 years and a license to carry a
3 concealed pistol issued on or after July 1, 2003 **BUT BEFORE JULY 1,**
4 **2006** is valid for 5 years, **AND A LICENSE TO CARRY A CONCEALED**

1 PISTOL ISSUED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2006 IS VALID UNTIL THE
2 APPLICANT'S DATE OF BIRTH THAT FALLS NOT LESS THAN 4 YEARS OR MORE
3 THAN 5 YEARS AFTER THE LICENSE IS ISSUED. A license that is renewed
4 before the immediately preceding license term expires, but not more
5 than 1 year before the immediately preceding license term expires,
6 shall bear an issue date that is identical to the expiration date
7 of the preceding license. A renewal of a license under section 5b
8 shall, except as provided in this section, be issued in the same
9 manner as an original license issued under section 5b.

10 (2) The concealed weapon licensing board shall issue or deny
11 issuance of a renewal license within 60 days after the application
12 for renewal is properly submitted. The county clerk shall issue the
13 applicant a receipt for his or her renewal application at the time
14 the application is submitted. The receipt shall contain all of the
15 following:

- 16 (a) The name of the applicant.
17 (b) The date and time the receipt is issued.
18 (c) The amount paid.
19 (d) A statement that the receipt is for a license renewal.
20 (e) A statement of whether the applicant qualifies for an
21 extension under subsection (3).
22 (f) The name of the county in which the receipt is issued.
23 (g) An impression of the county seal.

24 (3) If the concealed weapon licensing board fails to deny or
25 issue a renewal license to the person within 60 days as required
26 under subsection (2), the expiration date of the current license is
27 extended by 180 days or until the renewal license is issued,

1 whichever occurs first. This subsection does not apply unless the
2 person pays the renewal fee at the time the renewal application is
3 submitted and the person has submitted a receipt from a police
4 agency that confirms that a background check has been requested by
5 the applicant.

6 (4) A person carrying a concealed pistol after the expiration
7 date of his or her license pursuant to an extension under
8 subsection (3) shall keep the receipt issued by the county clerk
9 under subsection (2) and his or her expired license in his or her
10 possession at all times that he or she is carrying the pistol. For
11 the purposes of this act, the receipt is considered to be part of
12 the license to carry a concealed pistol until a renewal license is
13 issued or denied. Failing to have the receipt and expired license
14 in possession while carrying a concealed pistol or failing to
15 display the receipt to a peace officer upon request is a violation
16 of this act.

17 (5) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) are
18 waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or retired
19 law enforcement officer.

20 (6) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c) for an
21 applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under this act
22 are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he or she
23 has completed at least 3 hours' review of the training described
24 under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1 hour of firing range
25 time in the 6 months immediately preceding the subsequent
26 application.
