SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5043

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 540 (MCL 750.540).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 540. Cutting, tapping, using, etc., telephone or 2 telegraph wires, etc.—Any person who shall wilfully and maliciously 3 cut, break, tap or make any connection with, or read, or copy, by 4 the use of telegraph or telephone instruments, or otherwise, in any 5 unauthorized manner, any message, either social or business, 6 sporting, commercial or other news reports, from any telegraph or 7 telephone line, wire or cable so unlawfully cut or tapped in this 8 state; or make unauthorized use of the same, or who shall wilfully 9 and maliciously prevent, obstruct or delay by any means or

- 1 contrivance whatsoever the sending, conveyance or delivery, in this
- 2 state, of any authorized communication, sporting, commercial or
- 3 other news reports, by or through any telegraph or telephone line,
- 4 cable or wire under the control of any telegraph or telephone
- 5 company doing business in this state, or who shall wilfully and
- 6 maliciously aid, agree with, employ, or conspire with any other
- 7 person or persons to do any of the aforementioned unlawful acts,
- 8 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment in the
- 9 state prison not more than 2 years, or by a fine of not more than
- 10 1,000 dollars.
- 11 (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY CUT, BREAK,
- 12 DISCONNECT, INTERRUPT, TAP, OR MAKE ANY UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTION
- 13 WITH ANY ELECTRONIC MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION, INCLUDING THE INTERNET
- 14 OR A COMPUTER, COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER
- 15 NETWORK, OR A TELEPHONE.
- 16 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY READ OR COPY
- 17 ANY MESSAGE FROM ANY TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE LINE, WIRE, CABLE,
- 18 COMPUTER NETWORK, COMPUTER PROGRAM, OR COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR
- 19 TELEPHONE OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION THAT THE
- 20 PERSON ACCESSED WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION.
- 21 (3) A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY MAKE
- 22 UNAUTHORIZED USE OF ANY ELECTRONIC MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION,
- 23 INCLUDING THE INTERNET OR A COMPUTER, COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER
- 24 SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK, OR TELEPHONE.
- 25 (4) A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY AND MALICIOUSLY PREVENT,
- 26 OBSTRUCT, OR DELAY BY ANY MEANS THE SENDING, CONVEYANCE, OR
- 27 DELIVERY OF ANY AUTHORIZED COMMUNICATION, BY OR THROUGH ANY

- 1 TELEGRAPH OR TELEPHONE LINE, CABLE, WIRE, OR ANY ELECTRONIC MEDIUM
- 2 OF COMMUNICATION, INCLUDING THE INTERNET OR A COMPUTER, COMPUTER
- 3 PROGRAM, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- 4 (5) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CRIME AS
- 5 FOLLOWS:
- 6 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), THE PERSON IS
- 7 GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2
- 8 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 9 (B) IF THE INCIDENT TO BE REPORTED RESULTS IN INJURY TO OR THE
- 10 DEATH OF ANY PERSON, THE PERSON VIOLATING THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF
- 11 A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A
- 12 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 13 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 14 (A) "COMPUTER" MEANS ANY CONNECTED, DIRECTLY INTEROPERABLE OR
- 15 INTERACTIVE DEVICE, EQUIPMENT, OR FACILITY THAT USES A COMPUTER
- 16 PROGRAM OR OTHER INSTRUCTIONS TO PERFORM SPECIFIC OPERATIONS
- 17 INCLUDING LOGICAL, ARITHMETIC, OR MEMORY FUNCTIONS WITH OR ON
- 18 COMPUTER DATA OR A COMPUTER PROGRAM AND THAT CAN STORE, RETRIEVE,
- 19 ALTER, OR COMMUNICATE THE RESULTS OF THE OPERATIONS TO A PERSON,
- 20 COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- 21 (B) "COMPUTER NETWORK" MEANS THE INTERCONNECTION OF HARDWIRE
- 22 OR WIRELESS COMMUNICATION LINES WITH A COMPUTER THROUGH REMOTE
- 23 TERMINALS, OR A COMPLEX CONSISTING OF 2 OR MORE INTERCONNECTED
- 24 COMPUTERS.
- 25 (C) "COMPUTER PROGRAM" MEANS A SERIES OF INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL
- 26 INSTRUCTIONS COMMUNICATED IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO A COMPUTER THAT
- 27 DIRECTS THE FUNCTIONING OF A COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER

- NETWORK IN A MANNER DESIGNED TO PROVIDE OR PRODUCE PRODUCTS OR 1
- 2 RESULTS FROM THE COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- (D) "COMPUTER SYSTEM" MEANS A SET OF RELATED, CONNECTED OR 3
- 4 UNCONNECTED, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, DEVICES, SOFTWARE, OR HARDWARE.
- (E) "INTERNET" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 230 OF 5
- TITLE II OF THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1934, 47 USC 230, AND
- INCLUDES VOICE OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL SERVICES. 7
- (7) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED 8
- WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW
- COMMITTED BY THAT PERSON WHILE VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING TO VIOLATE 10
- THIS SECTION. 11
