# SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 444

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 216a (MCL 750.216a), as added by 1985 PA 78,
and by adding section 216b.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 216a. (1) A person shall not sell, furnish, or possess,
- 2 WEAR, EXHIBIT, DISPLAY, OR USE the badge, PATCH, OR UNIFORM, or
- 3 facsimile of the badge, PATCH, OR UNIFORM, of any law enforcement
- 4 agency unless any of the following -occur APPLY:
- 5 (a) The person receiving or possessing the badge, PATCH,
- 6 UNIFORM, or facsimile is authorized to receive or possess the
- 7 badge, PATCH, UNIFORM, or facsimile by the chief officer of the law
- 8 enforcement agency.

- 1 (b) The person receiving or possessing the badge, PATCH,
- 2 UNIFORM, or facsimile is a member of the law enforcement agency.
- 3 (c) The badge is a retirement badge AND IS IN THE POSSESSION
- 4 OF THE RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- 5 (d) The badge, PATCH, OR UNIFORM is the badge, PATCH, OR
- 6 UNIFORM of a deceased law enforcement officer AND IS IN THE
- 7 POSSESSION OF HIS OR HER SPOUSE, CHILD, OR NEXT OF KIN.
- 8 (e) The person receiving, —or possessing, EXHIBITING,
- 9 DISPLAYING, OR USING the badge, PATCH, UNIFORM, OR FACSIMILE is a
- 10 collector of badges, PATCHES, UNIFORMS, OR FACSIMILES. The A
- 11 badge, PATCH, UNIFORM, OR FACSIMILE POSSESSED AS PART OF A
- 12 COLLECTION shall be transported in a container or display case
- 13 WHEN BEING TRANSPORTED.
- 14 (F) THE PERSON IS IN THE THEATRICAL PROFESSION AND WEARS THE
- 15 BADGE, PATCH, UNIFORM, OR FACSIMILE WHILE ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN
- 16 FOLLOWING THAT PROFESSION.
- 17 (2) A person who violates this section is quilty of a
- 18 misdemeanor punishable by IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93
- 19 DAYS OR a fine of not more than -\$100.00 \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- 20 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION AND SECTION 216B, "FACSIMILE"
- 21 INCLUDES BOTH AN EXACT REPLICA OF AN EXISTING ITEM AND A CLOSE
- 22 IMITATION OF AN EXISTING ITEM.

- SEC. 216B. (1) A PERSON<<, OTHER THAN A PEACE OFFICER,>> SHALL NOT WEAR OR DISPLAY THE EMBLEM,
- 24 INSIGNIA, LOGO, SERVICE MARK, OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 25 IDENTIFICATION OF ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, OR A FACSIMILE OF ANY
- 26 OF THOSE ITEMS, IF EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:
- 27 (A) THE PERSON REPRESENTS HIMSELF OR HERSELF TO ANOTHER PERSON

- AS BEING A PEACE OFFICER. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "PEACE 1
- OFFICER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 215. 2
- (B) THE WEARING OR DISPLAY OCCURS IN A MANNER THAT WOULD LEAD 3
- 4 A REASONABLE PERSON TO FALSELY BELIEVE THAT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT
- AGENCY WHOSE EMBLEM, INSIGNIA, LOGO, SERVICE MARK, OR OTHER LAW 5
- ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION OR FACSIMILE IS BEING WORN OR DISPLAYED 6
- IS PROMOTING OR ENDORSING A COMMERCIAL SERVICE OR PRODUCT OR A 7

- 9 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93 DAYS OR 10
- 11 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
- (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LAW ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION" 12
- MEANS ANY IDENTIFICATION THAT CONTAINS THE WORDS "LAW ENFORCEMENT" 13
- OR SIMILAR WORDS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, "AGENT", 14
- "ENFORCEMENT AGENT", "DETECTIVE", "TASK FORCE", "FUGITIVE RECOVERY 15
- AGENT", OR ANY OTHER COMBINATION OF NAMES THAT GIVES THE IMPRESSION 16
- 17 THAT THE BEARER IS ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT,
- STATE GOVERNMENT, OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF A STATE 18
- 19 GOVERNMENT.
