## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 712

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 303a (MCL 750.303a), as added by 1996 PA 539.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 303a. This chapter does not apply to recreational card
- 2 playing conducted at a senior citizen housing facility OR A SENIOR
- 3 CITIZEN CENTER THAT IS NOT A HOUSING FACILITY IF ALL OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 5 (A) THE FACILITY OR CENTER IS not licensed by the liquor
- 6 control commission.
- 7 (B) THE CARD PLAYING IS CONDUCTED by a <u>senior citizens</u> club
- 8 or -a group COMPRISED of residents of -a senior citizen housing
- 9 THE facility that consists of OR MEMBERS OF THE CENTER, at least

- 1 15 -members who OF WHOM are 60 years of age or older. -under all
- 2 of the following circumstances:
- 3 (C)  $\frac{}{}$  (C)  $\frac{}{}$  The card playing is conducted solely for the
- 4 amusement and recreation of the members and guests of the club or
- 5 group and is not conducted for fund-raising. The number of guests
- 6 participating in the card playing shall not exceed the number of
- 7 club or group members participating in the card playing.
- 8 (D) -(b) Only bona fide members and employees of the club or
- 9 group participate in the conduct of the activity CONDUCTING THE
- 10 CARD PLAYING.
- 11 (E) (c) The EXCEPT ON A LEGAL HOLIDAY, THE card playing is
- 12 conducted after 9 a.m. and before 12 midnight.
- 13 (F)  $\frac{(d)}{(d)}$  The participating cardplayers bet not more than 25
- 14 cents per bet.
- 15 (G)  $\overline{\text{(e)}}$  The winnings from 1 hand of cards do not exceed
- **16** \$5.00.
- 17 (H)  $\frac{(f)}{(f)}$  Except for winnings, revenue generated from the
- 18 activity CARD PLAYING is used for reasonable expenses incurred in
- 19 conducting the card playing, and no person is compensated for
- 20 participating in the conduct of CONDUCTING the card playing.
