HOUSE BILL No. 4027

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Stewart and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 198, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of plant rehabilitation districts and industrial development districts in local governmental units; to provide for the exemption from certain taxes; to levy and collect a specific tax upon the owners of certain facilities; to impose and provide for the disposition of an administrative fee; to provide for the disposition of the tax; to provide for the obtaining and transferring of an exemption certificate and to prescribe the contents of those certificates; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state tax commission and certain officers of local governmental units; and to provide penalties,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 207.557), as amended by 1996 PA 513.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7. (1) Within 60 days after receipt of an approved application or an appeal of a disapproved application that was submitted to the commission before October 31 of that year, the commission shall determine whether the facility is a speculative

- 1 building or designed and acquired primarily for the purpose of
- 2 restoration or replacement of obsolete industrial property or the
- 3 construction of new industrial property, and whether the facility
- 4 otherwise complies with section 9 and with the other provisions of

- 6 facilities exemption certificate. Before issuing a certificate the

- 1 December 29, 1986 a local governmental unit passed a resolution
- 2 approving an exemption certificate for 10 years for real and

- 6 industrial facilities exemption certificate that begins December

- 14 ON DECEMBER 30, 2002 AND ENDS DECEMBER 30, 2009.
