

HOUSE BILL No. 4035

January 27, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Lipsey, Bieda and Kolb and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 17205.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 17205. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006, A MANUFACTURER OF
2 THERMOSTATS CONTAINING MERCURY OR A MERCURY COMPOUND INTENDED FOR
3 SALE IN THIS STATE OR FOR USE IN THIS STATE SHALL AFFIX A LABEL
4 INDICATING THAT THE THERMOSTAT CONTAINS MERCURY OR A MERCURY
5 COMPOUND TO EACH THERMOSTAT AND SHALL PROVIDE INSTRUCTIONS WITH THE
6 THERMOSTAT ON THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF THE THERMOSTAT AND PROPER
7 CLEANUP OF THE MERCURY OR MERCURY COMPOUND IF A SPILL, LEAK, OR
8 DISCHARGE OCCURS.

1 (2) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2010, A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR
2 OFFER FOR SALE A THERMOSTAT CONTAINING MERCURY OR A MERCURY
3 COMPOUND IN THIS STATE OR FOR USE IN THIS STATE.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 4058(request no.
6 00664'05) of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
