## **HOUSE BILL No. 4336**

February 17, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Newell and Meyer and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1267 (MCL 380.1267), as amended by 2004 PA 232.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1267. (1) Before commencing construction of a new school
- 2 building, or addition to or repair or renovation of an existing
- 3 school building, except repair in emergency situations, the board
- 4 of a school district or intermediate school district or board of
- 5 directors of a public school academy shall obtain competitive
- 6 bids on all the material and labor required for the complete
- construction of a proposed new building or addition to or repair or
- 3 renovation of an existing school building.

- 1 (2) The board, intermediate school board, or board of
- 2 directors shall advertise for the bids required under subsection
- 3 (1) by placing an advertisement for bids at least once in a
- 4 newspaper of general circulation in the area where the building or

- 7 advertisement for bids for at least 2 weeks on the department of
- 8 management and budget website on a page on the website maintained

- 2 (d) State that the bid shall MUST be accompanied by a sworn
- 3 and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that
- 4 exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any
- 5 member of the board, intermediate school board, or board of
- 6 directors or the superintendent of the school district,
- 7 intermediate superintendent of the intermediate school district, or
- 8 chief executive officer of the public school academy. A board,

- 24 (C) NEW CONSTRUCTION OR RENOVATIONS OR REPAIRS TO A BUILDING
- 25 IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE MET:
- 26 (i) THE WORK IS PERFORMED BY PUPILS ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM
- 27 OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR

- 1 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY AS PART OF THEIR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION
- 2 INSTRUCTION.
- 3 ( $\ddot{u}$ ) THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
- 4 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY DOES NOT INTEND TO USE ANY PART OF THE
- 5 BUILDING FOR CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION OR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.
- 6 (iii) THE ESTIMATED COST OF THE WORK IS LESS THAN \$200,000.
