

HOUSE BILL No. 5276

October 6, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Nofs, Newell and Condino and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1925 PA 289, entitled

"An act to create and maintain a fingerprint identification and criminal history records division within the department of state police; to require peace officers, persons in charge of certain institutions, and others to make reports respecting juvenile offenses, crimes, and criminals to the state police; to require the fingerprinting of an accused by certain persons; and to provide penalties and remedies for a violation of this act,"

(MCL 28.241 to 28.248) by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 2A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), ALL
2 CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION THAT IS ASSOCIATED WITH A STATE
3 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AND IS SUPPORTED BY FINGERPRINT IMPRESSIONS
4 SHALL BE DISSEMINATED IN RESPONSE TO A FINGERPRINT-BASED OR NAME-
5 BASED SEARCH OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD DATABASE.

6 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT REQUIRE THE DISSEMINATION OF

1 CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION THAT IS NONPUBLIC OR IS PROHIBITED BY
2 LAW FROM BEING DISSEMINATED.
