

# HOUSE BILL No. 5284

October 11, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Wenke and Gosselin and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 12f of chapter XVII (MCL 777.12f), as amended by 2003 PA 134.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 CHAPTER XVII

2 Sec. 12f. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
3 enumerated in sections 625 to 625o of chapter VI of the Michigan  
4 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, within chapter 257 of the Michigan
